A seed for Belóved Gallery was planted when its co-founders, Lewis and Kirsten Cirne, acquired Akiane Kramarik's world-renowned painting, *Prince of Peace*. Captivated by the supernatural account surrounding its creation and astounded by the hope the painting inspires, they knew *Prince of Peace* was meant to be shared with the world. They dreamed about creating a space where a million people could have their own experience with the painting, with one founding purpose: to honor God, our Creator, thus amplifying Akiane's message of unwavering faith, unconditional love, and eternal life. They chose Marble Falls, Texas, USA, as the site for Belóved Gallery.

Belóved Gallery opened its doors in April 2023 as the only public exhibition of Akiane's works worldwide, sharing this remarkable collection with guests from over 50 countries and counting.


OUR VISION

Now, *Prince of Peace*, considered one of the most recognized faces of Jesus worldwide, hangs on the wall in the Belóved Gallery after nearly two decades of being hidden away. The extraordinary story of the painting's creation, disappearance, and miraculous recovery is the heartbeat of Belóved Gallery's premier exhibition, *Akiane: The Early Years*.

PRINCE OF PEACE: LOST & FOUND VIDEO



Akiane: The Early Years, the only public exhibition of Akiane's work worldwide, is a remarkable collection spotlighting 14 of Akiane's original childhood paintings. At the pinnacle of the exhibition is the Prince of Peace painting, available for in-person viewings for the first time since its creation. Among the collection are works such as Dreams and The Missing Years, also reimagined from Akiane's visions of heaven, and Turquoise Eyes, Akiane's eleven-year-old self-portrait. Each painting includes accompanying poetry and deep reflections written by Akiane.

The Lost & Found Timeline details the story of the Prince of Peace and includes Akiane's childhood photographs. Akiane: A Portrait of the Artist, the exclusive short film that plays in Belóved Gallery's media room, follows Akiane's journey through poverty, childhood fame, and tragic loss to becoming the master fine artist she is today. Belóved Gallery seeks to amplify Akiane's message of unwavering faith, unconditional love, and eternal life through this unique exhibition, opening a doorway of hope for all who hear her story.

About Akiane



Internationally recognized fine artist, poet, best-selling author, philanthropist, filmmaker, entrepreneur, visionary, and art ambassador, Akiane Kramarik, is regarded as one of the world's most accomplished and versatile living artists. A former child prodigy, she is considered by many art experts to be the youngest binary genius in both realistic art and poetry. Her portraits of Jesus remain the most recognized face of Jesus across the world today. Akiane's creations have been exhibited in art galleries, museums, embassies, and private institutions, as well as collected by

world leaders, CEOs, and celebrities. She has traveled to over 33 countries, lived in eight states, seven countries, and on four continents.

Akiane's practice has diversified across a myriad of genres, styles, and mediums, ranging from hyperreal large-scale acrylic or oil compositions to more fluid, almost abstract works that include glass and gold. Drawing inspiration from her travels, meditations, dreams, visions, and serendipitous encounters, her mission is to make the invisible accessible through poetic visual language. She spreads messages of peace and hope through creating art that has an authentic healing energy. Akiane imbues her works with intricate and multifaceted symbolism. Landscapes, portraits, and stories are transcendent metaphors purposefully left unrestricted by any space or time.

Akiane considers herself an explorer and a steadfast interpreter of diverse epochs, cultures, faiths, and worlds. It is common to find a number of her originals displaying superimposed messages, hidden stories, encrypted codes, and quantum holograms, especially in soulscapes - mystic landscapes of the soul and visionary interpretations of the soul's journey through life.

Above all, the artist attributes her talent and success to her solid family support, home education, diligent work ethic, perseverance, and unique cultural and spiritual influences.

Through narrative retellings, exclusive interviews, and groundbreaking cinematography, this feature film will explore a theme surrounding the power of art to uplift the human experience.

THE STORY

We live in a time when God is moving in extraordinary ways to reveal the depths of His unconditional love. The renowned painting of a child prodigy reflects the life of Jesus when He walked the earth thousands of years ago, recreating an experience of meeting Him face to face. Near-death experiences filling the media airwaves create a vision of an afterlife that exceeds our imaginations. Skyscraper-high photos from the faith-inspired show *The Chosen* adorn Times Square. Scientists tracking prodigious phenomena, such as telepathy in non-speaking autistic people, are discovering Jesus at the root. None of these happenings are meant to take Jesus's place but rather provide an open door to the greatest love story ever told – a love story for all mankind.

TIMELINE

The Akiane Feature Film is in its research and development phase, which will continue through 2025. The film crew, along with Akiane, will capture content over 18 months, traveling to multiple countries in 2026. Narrative scenes and expansive footage captured inside Akiane's studio will give viewers an inside look at Akiane's remarkable story and creative process. Post-production will begin in 2027, with an anticipated film release and festival circuit tour beginning in late 2028.

Funding will cover research and development, film production across six countries, post-production, and global distribution.
