The exhibition *Akiane: A Journey of Faith through Art* by American prodigy artist Akiane Kramarik is being extended through Sunday, March 1, 2026, due to strong public response. The exhibition is currently on view at SaRang Church (121 Banpo-daero, Seocho-gu, Seoul).

The exhibition is sponsored by the U.S.-based nonprofit art foundation Belóved Gallery and is presented as a large-scale show, with the entire B5 level of SaRang Church newly transformed into a gallery space. Since opening on November 2, 2025, the exhibition has drawn close to 10,000 visitors and has left a deep impression on audiences.

Akiane gained worldwide attention after her portrait of Jesus, *Prince of Peace*, painted at the age of eight, was featured on The Oprah Winfrey Show and CNN. The current exhibition presents more than 20 of her major works, along with a six-minute immersive film, a 27-meter LED artwork, and screenings of an Akiane documentary film, offering visitors a profound spiritual and artistic experience through diverse media art formats.

In particular, the exhibition has drawn heightened attention because “Prince of Peace,” which was once stolen and remained missing for nearly 20 years, has miraculously returned to the artist and is now being shown in Korea for the first time outside the United States..

This exhibition is expected to offer a unique opportunity to experience the gospel and a journey of faith through art.
